



Blocking Rehearsal Information

At MFAC, we strive to give our students the most professional performance experiences possible. The week prior to each performance is tech and dress rehearsal week, also known as production week. During production week, our technical staff and students have the opportunity to become comfortable with the theater space and to complete any last minute tasks prior to the performance. In order to eliminate the long waiting periods immediately before dress rehearsal, we have created a blocking schedule so that you may better plan your trips to and from the theater.

Blocking rehearsals allow the technical crew to understand the spacing and choreography in order to better light the children on stage. Moreover, they allow young children to become acclimated with the theater prior to the thrill of dress rehearsal and performance. They will become more familiar with the theater and stage and have the opportunity ask any last minute questions they may have.

Blocking rehearsals are especially important for our youngest students. This first opportunity to dance at the Whaley Auditorium will help to calm nerves, and hopefully help relieve any stage fright or fear.

Please arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled blocking rehearsal.

Students should wear the appropriate dance attire and proper shoes at all blocking rehearsals.
