

MFAC Stage Make-Up

You will need:

- ✓ Base or Foundation one shade darker than your natural skintone
- ✓ Translucent Loose Powder
- ✓ White eye shadow/creme pencil
- ✓ Brown eye shadow/creme pencil (darker brown for students 9 & up, lighter brown for students 8 & Under)
- ✓ Black eyeliner
- ✓ Black mascara
- ✓ Pink/Rosey Blush
- ✓ Rosey Lipstick (nothing too brown as it shows up black on stage)

1) Skin –

- a. Smooth foundation over the entire face, including lips, eyelids, and the under eye area.
- b. Smooth translucent powder over the entire face.
- c. With a sponge, powder brush, or powder puff, leave extra loose powder on cheekbones and under eyes. *(This will catch any extra eye shadow that falls onto the cheeks, and is to be brushed off in later steps.)*

2) Eyebrows

- a. With brow comb, brush and shape brows.
- b. Fill in eyebrows with eye shadow color that matches or is slightly darker than hair color. Stay true to natural shape of the brow.

3) Eyes –

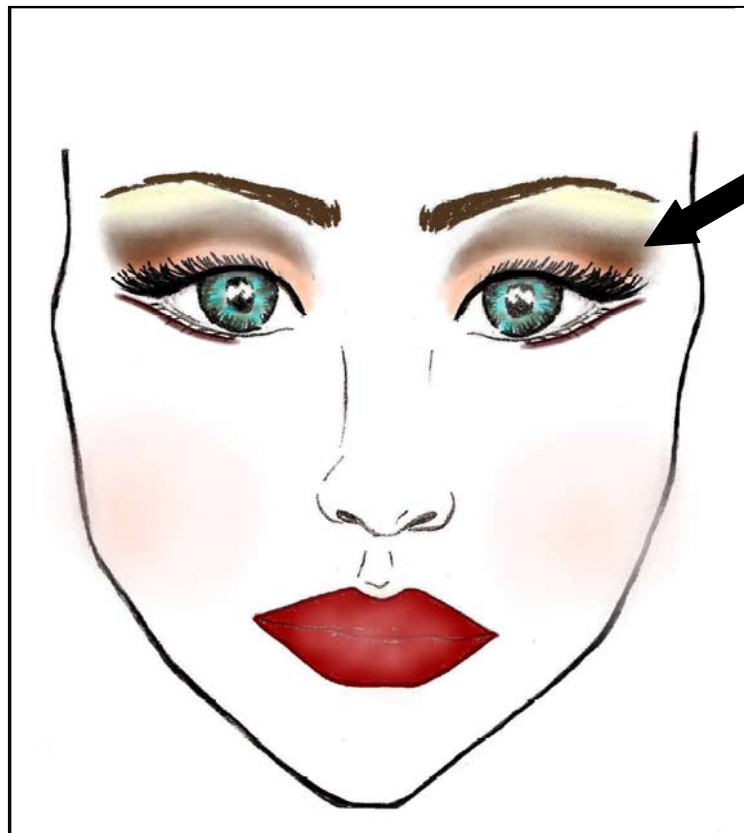
- a. Highlight brow bone with white eye shadow or crème pencil.
- b. Fill in the entire eyelid and inner corner of the eye with white eye shadow or white crème pencil.
- c. Cover the crease with the brown shadow or brown crème pencil.
- d. With large powder brush, brush the extra translucent powder from under the eye.
- e. Draw a line on the upper lash line with black eye liner from the inner corner to the outer corner of the eye and extending slightly outward and upward.
- f. Line the bottom eye from the center of the iris to the outside corner of the eye, extending slightly outward.
- g. Apply white shadow or crème pencil in between the two lines of eyeliner.
- h. Once liner is dry, very lightly brush translucent powder on top of the entire eye & eyelid area, as well as eyelashes, to set the eye make-up.
- h. Coat upper and lower eyelashes with black mascara.

4) Cheeks –

- a. With blush brush, contour just under and slightly on cheekbone starting at the apples of the cheeks and extending outward towards the hairline.
- e. With large powder brush, smooth translucent powder over blush to blend.

5) Lips –

- a. Fill in lips with a rose pink color lipstick that suits your complexion. *Stay away from any colors that are too brown, as they will show up black underneath stage lights.*

Pencil on the eyelid
