



What to Bring--Sample Check List

Young students should come to the theater with their hair and makeup done.

Costumes in garment bags on hangers.	
All shoes (tap, jazz, ballet, lyrical, sandal soles, pedinis, etc)	
All hair pieces and accessories.	
A cover-up large enough to fit over your costume	
A bag or laundry basket to keep your street clothes in.	
For older students, a garment rack to hang your costumes on.	
For quick changes, a laundry basket to throw your costume pieces in.	
Makeup Kits	
Makeup remover and cloths, if you wish to take off your makeup before you leave.	
Q-Tips, toilet paper, tissues	
Hair nets, hair pins, bobby pins, gel, hair spray and brushes.	
Band aids, ace bandages and ice packs (optional, we will have many first aid kits).	
Water, water, water. A water bottle with your name on it works best.	
Snacks for you and 6 other people to share with your dressing room buddies. No messy snacks please. Pretzels, crackers and other non-residue leaving items are best. *Remember to avoid products containing nut products!	
Books, cards, and activities for while you are waiting	
Walk-man, CD's, iPod, Gameboys, etc. (Make sure your name is on each item: MFAC is not responsible for lost items.)
