



Theater Etiquette

In the auditorium

1. No food or drinks are allowed in the theater space. Concessions will be sold in the atrium if you wish to purchase a snack. Do not allow your children to eat or drink in their costumes.
2. For the safety of our performers and to protect our royalty policies, the use of cameras and video cameras is prohibited during performances.
3. Remember to silence all cell phones and pagers during the performance.
4. Only enter and exit the auditorium during breaks in the performance. The closing & opening of auditorium doors can disrupt the performance and distract our performers and technical staff.

Backstage & Dressing Areas

5. Students should not leave their designated dressing rooms wearing costumes or without the supervision and permission of the dressing room attendant. If you must leave the dressing area, please cover your costume and alert the dressing room attendant.
6. Remember to remain quiet in backstage areas.
7. Props and set pieces crowd the backstage area. Please do not enter the backstage area without authorization.
8. For security purposes, guests and friends may not enter backstage and dressing areas. Males will not be permitted in female dressing areas. Only volunteers carrying a backstage pass will be permitted to enter the secure areas during the performances.
9. Do not visit the dressing rooms during the show. Only mothers of students may go to the dressing rooms at intermission. No guests please!
10. Please sign your child (ren) in and out of dressing room areas. Siblings may not sign students in or out.
11. Due to security reasons and space issues, parents will be asked to exit dressing rooms 20 minutes prior to dress rehearsal and 45 minutes prior to the performance.
12. We will attempt to furnish dressing rooms with a closed-circuit television, which will air the live performance.

Miscellaneous

13. A positive attitude is infectious! When adults practice positive behavior, children will follow! Please remain calm, courteous and respectful throughout this experience.
14. Please present any flowers or gifts to performers following the show. Do not approach the stage or technical booth at any time -- including during the finale/curtain call.
15. Have fun and stay focused! You have dedicated your time, talents, and energy throughout this entire year. Now it's your time to shine
